DWR Flood Preparedness Efforts & Flood ER Grants


- Flood Safety Planning prepares locals, counties, and regions

- SB 27 Task Force Recommendation
- Funded Activities include purchase and installation of communications equipment and communications plans.
- 6 projects funded for 6 participating agencies
- Grant close out in 2016.




Delta Communication Grants Highlights

- Twitchell Radio Tower
 - Installed by Sacramento County
 - Total Cost \$2.2M, \$1.5M provided by DWR Grant
- Prior to installation, reliable communications in this part of the Delta did not exist.
- Reliably connects all 5 counties and DWR.



Statewide Flood ER Grants- ALERT2 Project Example


Ventura County

- Total awarded \$840K for round 1 and \$780K for round 2
- Update the Automated Local Evaluation in Real Time (ALERT)2 system
- Consists of gages, transmitters, repeaters, and base stations to collect and share rainfall and stream data
- Reliable gage data is critical for flood warning, evacuation, and response



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Forecasted-Coordinated Operations (F-CO) Grants

- F-CO goal is to reduce peak flows downstream of reservoirs during flood events.
- Improved data collection and forecasting tools needed to time improve management and coordination of releases.



- Agencies responsible for operating a reservoir with a flood control reservation pool are eligible.
- Up to \$6 million available
- Directed funding



Forecasted Coordinated Operations Grants

Activities:

- Equipment needed for data collection, dissemination, and exchange
- Watershed and river forecasting tools
- Decision Support System (DSS)
- Training and exercises

Current grantees:

- Kings River Conservation District- Pine Flat (\$1 million)
- Merced Irrigation District- New Exchequer (\$647k)
